

The 1st Christian Church of Glendale Scholarship

(Scholarship Application Cover Sheet)

About the Scholarship: The First Christian Church of Glendale Scholarship was established in 2005. This annual scholarship award is given thanks to the generosity of past members of the church. Applicants must profess a belief that Jesus Christ is the Son of God and their personal Savior, in addition to fitting the student profile below and meeting all other requirements.

College Major/Area of Study: Any

Student Profile: Student must show proof of a minimum of 13 years residency in the Glendale, La Crescenta, La Cañada Flintridge, Montrose, Verdugo City, Sunland or Tujunga area, even if attending other area private or public high schools. An example of fulfilling this criterion might be by providing a copy of a bill, rental agreement, mortgage/deed documentation, school transcript, parent's marriage certificate or other credible form from 13 years ago; showing that the address is/was in the specified areas above. Additionally, the student must have a minimum overall 2.5 GPA and must be a U.S. Citizen.

Special Requirement: A personal essay explaining his/her religious belief that Jesus Christ is the Son of God and his/her personal Savior and view on what it means to be an American.

Awards Range Between: \$250 - \$1,000 annually. Award may be renewable during undergraduate education only. *Note: Renewal information will be provided at the appropriate time.*

Average # of Awards: Vary

Application Packet Required Materials:

- 2016/2017 Community Foundation of the Verdugos Scholarship Application.
- Personal Essay (see "**Special Requirement**").
- Official Academic Transcript (with ACT &/or SAT scores) arranged to be sent.
- Student Aid Report (**SAR**) that is generated from submitting your 2017-2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). If you need assistance obtaining or printing it, call for customer support at 1-800-433-3243/1-800-4-FED-AID or visit www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- Confidential Letter of Recommendation arranged to be sent.
- Proof of U.S. Citizenship (copy of current passport, birth certificate, or certificate of naturalization).
- Proof of 13 years residency in specified areas (see "**Student Profile**").

Additional Information:

Awardees will be expected to attend CFV's Scholarship Recognition Event May 20, 2017. Enrollment Verification form with official university or college stamp or seal, once enrolled full time for fall semester is required before the scholarship is paid.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
