

Tuesday Afternoon Club Scholarship (Scholarship Application Cover Sheet)

About the Scholarship: The Tuesday Afternoon Club (TAC) began over 100 years ago with 8 Glendale women who played bridge every Tuesday. The TAC women founded the Glendale Library in 1907 which housed approximately 100 books in a rented poolroom. Upon the dissolution of the Club in 1999, the Board members chose to place remaining assets in a fund with the Community Foundation. In fact, the TAC was among the community groups responsible for the creation of the Community Foundation of the Verdugos (then known as the Glendale Community Foundation) in 1956. The collaboration between the Club and the Foundation has enjoyed a long history and in addition, has provided scholarships to graduating Glendale Unified School District students.

College Major/Area of Study: Any

Student Profile: Student must be a graduating senior from a private or public high school within the Glendale Unified School District and must be continuing his/her education at a university/college, or career technical institution. Financial need must be demonstrated, along with proof of U.S. Citizenship and community service. The student should be able to show a potential for achievement, success, and self-motivation.

Special Requirement: In a personal essay the student must discuss the importance of education.

Average Award: \$1,000

- 2016/2017 Community Foundation of the Verdugos Scholarship Application.
- Personal Essay (see “**Special Requirement**”).
- Official Academic Transcript (with ACT &/or SAT scores) arranged to be sent.
- Student Aid Report (**SAR**) that is generated from submitting your 2017-2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). If you need assistance obtaining or printing it, call for customer support at 1-800-433-3243/1-800-4-FED-AID or visit www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- Confidential Letter of Recommendation arranged to be sent.
- Proof of U.S. Citizenship (copy of current passport, birth certificate, or certificate of naturalization).
- Proof of Community Service.

Awardees will be expected to attend CFV’s Scholarship Recognition Event May 20, 2017. Enrollment Verification form with official university/college/career technical school stamp or seal, once enrolled full time for fall semester is required before the scholarship is paid.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
